Dear Parents and Guardians:

The start of the school year is almost here! We are so excited to welcome our Judges back to school. The first day of school will be Thursday, August 10. Class will start at 8:25 a.m each day and end at 3:15 pm. Students can start being dropped off at the Handley Circle at 8:05 a.m. The doors at Jefferson St. Circle entrance will also be open for walkers at 8:05 a.m. We will not allow students to enter the building before 8:05 a.m. due to supervision. If students start their morning at the Innovation Center they may be dropped off in the loop at 536 Jefferson Street. WPS buses drop off students at the Innovation Center before dropping students off at Handley. It is important that students remember to bring their Chromebook charged each day. Students will need to access their courses through Canvas. We encourage them to check their email daily and check their grades weekly. Powerschool is the official gradebook of Winchester Public Schools.

Students may access their schedule in PowerSchool. If you or your student need PowerSchool access, you may email Brandy Woods, Registrar (woodsb@wps.k12.va.us). Please understand that changes are still being made to schedules and your student should continue to check PowerSchool for updates as we get closer to August 10. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your student's schedule you may contact the assigned school counselor directly. Our counselors are assigned alphabetically by last name.

Students should turn in the adjustment request forms to their counselor. Counselors will review the requests in the order in which they are received. On **Monday, August 7 from 5:00-7:00 p.m** we will host our **Meet the Teacher & Open House** event. During this time, there will be an opportunity to meet your child's teachers and receive a syllabus for each course. The syllabus will explain the course content, necessary materials, and include teacher specific information. If you are unable to provide materials for your child, please let us know. We will have a bus available in the back of John Handley High School to shuttle families to the Innovation Center. We will have a variety of tables set up in the wooden hallway and cafeteria at John Handley High School that will provide further information regarding clubs and athletics, bus routes, PTSO, and PowerSchool/Canvas. Counselors will also be available to discuss schedules in the cafeteria.


