SUPT'S EMAIL: New Measures to Contain the Spread of COVID-19

On Friday, November 13, 2020, Governor Ralph S. Northam <u>announced new statewide</u> measures to contain the spread of COVID-19.

The measures include the expansion of the existing mask mandate to require children age 5 and older to wear a face covering in indoor public settings. **This does apply to children over 5 in public schools**, as is developmentally appropriate.

Additionally, public and private social gatherings are limited to 25 individuals. The social gathering limit **does** <u>not</u> apply to instructional educational settings, including classrooms, buses, cafeterias, and recess. The 25 person limit applies to the total number of <u>spectators</u> at athletic competitions. Additional details will be forthcoming from VHSL.
