

# Quarantine Guidelines

## Daily Schedule

Students that are quarantined and have classes at John Handley High School will follow [John Handley High School](#) bell schedule.

Students that are quarantined and take courses at the Emil & Grace Shihadeh Innovation Center will follow the [Innovation Center](#) bell schedule.

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## Google Meet

All teachers will be responsible for sharing a Google Meet on their Canvas page to students that are quarantined. A Google Meet is required for every block and every day a student is in quarantine

It is recommended that teachers close out of the Google Meet at the end of each block and use a different code for every block.

If a teacher has a student that is quarantined, it is recommended to send them a message in Canvas to review the schedule and code in order to join the class on their designated class period time. Sample message:

*Hello. I am sorry to hear that you will not be in school. Please click on the Google Meet link for your class period. You will attend the Google Meet during regularly scheduled class. You will also continue to work on your modules in Canvas. It is important that you log-in everyday so that I can mark you present for class. Please let me know if you have any questions.*

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## Attendance

Students will be marked with the "CVD" code in PowerSchool. Teachers are responsible for monitoring student participation in the Google Meet. If a student participates in class, the "CVD" will remain in place. If a student does not log into the Google Meet or is completely disengaged the code should revert to "AEX".
