What are Summer Residential Governor's Schools (SRGS)?

The Summer Residential Governor's Schools are month-long residential programs for current year tenth- and eleventh-grade gifted students in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Governor's Schools are designed for highly motivated students who are looking for a challenging summer experience. The selection process is extremely competitive. Most students selected rank in the top 10% of their class and have scored in the 90th percentile on standardized measures of ability or achievement tests. These residential programs run from late June to late July. Only students who are available during that time frame and whose records match these criteria should apply.

Academic SRGS: Important Dates

- October/November 2022: Alert counselor's office of interest
- January 26, 2024: Online applications open
- January-February 2024: Your school will conduct screening and collect data to determine who will advance from the school level to the state level.
- February 15, 2024: Letters of recommendation, essays and supporting documents are due to the JHHS Counselor's Office.
- February 20, 2024: Candidates will receive an email from the Counselor's Office regarding application status. IF you advance to the state level, you are not guaranteed automatic qualification for the summer program.
- April 2024: For those of you who moved to the state level, you will receive a letter from the state noting your status with the Governor's school. From that point forward, all communication about the logistics of the experience will come from the state.


Visual & Performing Arts Governor's School Opportunities

Students must contact their counselor and begin the online application by January 8, 2024 and submit completed applications by January 31, 2024. WPS must complete online testing of candidate and related data entry no later than January 25, 2024.
