Summer Residential Governor's School Programs 2023

What are Summer Residential Governor's Schools (SRGS)?

The Summer Residential Governor's Schools are month-long residential programs for <u>current</u> <u>year tenth- and eleventh-grade</u> gifted students in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Governor's Schools are designed for highly motivated students who are looking for a challenging summer experience. The selection process is extremely competitive. Most students selected rank in the top 10% of their class and have scored in the 90th percentile on standardized measures of ability or achievement tests. These residential programs run from late June to late July. Only students who are available during that time frame and whose records match these criteria should apply.

Academic SRGS: Important Dates

- October/November 2022: Alert counselor's office of interest
- January 27, 2023: Online applications open
- January-February 2023: Your school will conduct screening and collect data to determine who will advance from the school level to the state level.
- February 17, 2023: Letters of recommendation, essays and supporting documents are due to the JHHS Counselor's Office.
- February 20, 2023: Candidates will receive an email from the Counselor's Office regarding application status. IF you advance to the state level, you are not guaranteed automatic qualification for the summer program.
- April 2021: For those of you who moved to the state level, you will receive a letter from the state noting your status with the Governor's school. From that point forward, all communication about the logistics of the experience will come from the state.
